DESPRE PROJECT

The project is parallel to Erasmus+ project under the same title. It is designed to explore the diversity by working on the inclusion and integration of students with disabilities or other vulnerable social groups at risk of social exclusion. Solidarity involves the development of empathy, tolerance, communication and social skills. The project contributes to reducing the intellectual and social development of students, which is a great loss to European values. With this project we want to encourage every student to express themselves, their thoughts by giving everyone equal chances. The activities of the project will enable students to socialize, learn more for each other, and develop empathy, tolerance, communication, social and cultural skills. Activities that are planned in the project are related to school curriculum (music; art, literature, sport, ICT etc.)

OBIECTIVE

The project aims for our students to:

- 1) increase their level of communicative English;
- 2) raise their level of ICT skills through getting to know new programmes and applications such as PADlet, Google; Drive, Easelly, Fodey, Flipbook, film making programmes;
- 3) raise their awareness of using legal materials from the Internet - Creative Commons Licence;
- 4) make them more understanding the importance of diversity in our society;
- 5) make them more sensitive to various adversities in peoples' lives

PROCEDURĂ DE LUCRU

The coordinators from each school are in constant contact exchanging the ideas. They will also use LIVE options from eTwinning to communicate. Students will use chatroom on LIVE.

Responsibilities are divided equally. Each school is responsible for the specific area: Poland - ICT and eTwinning management, Romania - reports on Erasmus+ mobilities, Macedonia - inclusion activities, Spain, Croatia - Art and literature related activities,

The programme of the activities:

1. We will work with students weekly or monthly starting with getting to know each other activities.
2. Presentation of our schools, towns, countries
3. Stories of inclusion
4. In the art room - showing our work, discussions about the paintings students made
5. Reports of fund-raising events organised at schools
6. "See the world through my soul" activities and discussions
7. "Eyes wide open" activities and discussions
8. "We can make a change together" activities and discussions.
9. Summing up 2-year work works in various areas.
